SECRETARY MERRILL ON THE PRESIDENT'S VOTER FRAUD COMMISSION

HARTFORD: Connecticut Secretary of the State Denise Merrill, said, "The rationale for this commission was articulated in a baseless tweet from the president that claimed millions of illegal votes were cast. The facts don't lie. Voter fraud is extremely rare. Yet time and again, the specter of voter fraud has served as an excuse to disenfranchise tens of thousands of eligible voters. I hope that this investigation is not a fig leaf for voter suppression and intimidation. In Connecticut, we will protect every eligible person's right to vote. I stand by our process and our elections officials."
