## **Important Election Day Information**:

Polls are open from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. on February 28, 2017 for the special election. Voters can find their polling places and other important election information at myvote.ct.gov. There is no Election Day Registration for special elections.

Anyone encountering problems at the polls can contact either the Secretary of the State's office at 860-509-6100 or the State Elections Enforcement Commission at 860-256-2940 or by sending an email to elections@ct.gov. Voters who call or email with issues at the polls can either state their name or report problems anonymously but are asked to identify the town and polling place where they are observing the situation and provide as many specific details as possible.
