- Recommendation 1: Standardized, Uniform Curriculum
  - o Language Concerns
  - o Importance of Review on annual Basis
  - o Statutory or Administrative Authority to change this?
  - o Concern of who supervises curriculum
  - There sixty+ private commercial schools and about a dozen school training programs
  - o Could this raise cost?
  - o Add consecutive requirement to classroom training
  - o Add timeframe-draft available for public comment within a year
  - o "Be provided" instead of "available" in language?
  - o Add develop and implement
  - o Bill Seymour pointed out passenger restrictions are not being enforced, males are the primary problem, a lot of frequent flyers to retraining classes, many young people go to the retraining and as people age, then number of who are in retraining drops.
  - o Accepted
- Recommendation 2: DMV Test
  - o Following too close be moved from basic to critical skill
  - o Add "and evaluate" after encourage
  - o Tentatively passed
- Recommendation 3: Parent Orientation
  - o Already proposed in bill
  - o Variety of options are available for who/how to conduct
    - Likely to happened through driving schools in similar to drug and alcohol manner
  - o Will endorse current legislation-not offer as proposal
- Recommendation 4: Simulators
  - o CT Medical Center doing current research. Looking to do pilot for simulators/scanners in schools
  - o Scanning was proposed as better alternative to simulators
  - o Leave at monitoring CT Children's Medical Center program
- Recommendation 5: Driving Instructor Evaluation
  - o What is "effective?"
  - o Tabled
- Recommendation 6: Retraining
  - o Delete
- Recommendation 7: 18 and 19 year old restrictions
  - o Discussion: should education be separated by gender or should gender be considered in curriculum

- o Tabled
- Recommendation 8: Retraining
  - o Combine with #14; take out naming specific vendors
  - o Integrate into #14; delete as stand along
- Recommendation 9: Suspension
  - o Move into #14
  - o Delete
- Recommendation 10: Health Education Curriculum
  - o Suggest to Public Health Committee
  - o Eliminate last sentence and change drivers education to traffic safety
  - o Tabled
- Recommendation 11: Tracking
  - o Add warning to current tracking form
  - o Merge into #2 and delete as stand alone
- Recommendation 12: Enforcement
  - o Some things already being addressed
  - o Pass but with language changes
- Recommendation 13: Admin Per Se
  - o Endorse law recommendation
  - o Delete
- Recommendation 14: Violator Education
  - o Rework working integrating elements from other recommendations that are similar
  - o Passed
- Recommendation 15: Parents
  - o Suggest to parental awareness committee

It was decided to condense the recommendations into four umbrella recommendations:

- Drivers Education and Testing
- Police Education and Enforcement
- Violator Retraining
- Parental Outreach and Education
