Update: Two new agency websites and six additional websites launched in Sitecore!

In October, November, and December 2020, two agency websites and six additional websites from the Office of Governor and the Department of Labor launched on the Sitecore content management system. If your agency website contains hyperlinks to pages or files on any of these newly-launched websites, the recommendation is to update those hyperlinks to the new page or file using the Internal Sitecore link.

Content Author Self-Guided Training features:

• Covers Sitecore fundamentals - how to create and edit pages, upload images and document files, lock and unlock pages, submit pages for approval, and more.

- Short quizzes to highlight important items to remember for editing your website.

Now is the time to create the 2021 Press Release folder. Once published, press releases added to that folder will auto populate onto your homepage, if that feature is enabled on your agency's website.

Support: Frequently Asked Questions

When I log into Sitecore, I am taken to the Connecticut's Official State Website
 (https://authoring.ct.gov/). How do I get to my Agency website to edit?
 Please be sure to use this URL formatting when attempting to access Sitecore:
 https://authoring.ct.gov/sitecore/login

If you use any other variation such as https://authoring.ct.gov/sitecore, you will be brought to the authoring homepage and not the Sitecore dashboard.

- 2. I cannot log into Sitecore. It tells me my username or password is not valid. In the majority of cases, users will use their State email address as their Sitecore username since they are very similar. Your Sitecore username contains an @ct.egov.com extension, so your Sitecore username is likely something like firstname.lastname@ct.egov.com. If you have any questions on what your username might be or have any login issues, please reach out to the NIC Connecticut Helpdesk at ci-customerservice@egov.com.
- 3. I want to upload a video and have it play directly on my web page. How do I do that?

 Do not upload video files into your Sitecore Media Library. Instead, contact CT DAS/BEST at pmg@ct.gov and send them the media file(s) you wish to add to your web pages in Sitecore. Once received, they will upload the files onto their servers where the video will stream.

You can then embed the videos into you web page in Sitecore with an iFrame. For more instructions on this process, visit: https://portal.ct.gov/Training/Content-Author/Creating-a-New-Page/Add-Content-Images-and-More/Insert-an-iFrame.
