Update: One new agency website and one additional website launched in Sitecore!

In January, February, March 2021, one agency website and another Department of Public Health website launched on the Sitecore content management system. If your agency website contains hyperlinks to pages or files on any of these newly-launched websites, the recommendation is to update those hyperlinks to the new page or file using the Internal Sitecore link.

- 2. <u>CT Vaccine Portal</u> NIC CT and the State's digital team have been helping across agencies to respond to the COVID-19 pandemic.

One remaining agency website is in the process of migrating into the new Sitecore system and is targeting to launch their new website in the near future.

Hot Topic: When to delete media library items and when to overwrite

When going through the decision of whether to overwrite a media library item or delete it, consider the differences:

- 1. <u>Delete</u> Removes the item completely from the system. If anything is linked to that deleted item, a relink process is prompted to take action on what the system should to do: remove links, link to another item, or leave links.
- 2. Overwrite For document files you update on a regular basis, ensure visitors always get the latest version by overwriting the document file. This will ensure no links to your document are broken and any document properties (content title, teaser, etc.) you previously added remain intact.

- I cannot log into Sitecore. It tells me my username or password is not valid.
 In the majority of cases, your Sitecore username will be your firstname.lastname followed by a @ct.egov.com extension, so your Sitecore username is likely firstname.lastname@ct.egov.com. If you have any questions on what your username might be or have any login issues, please reach out to the NIC Connecticut Helpdesk at ci-customerservice@egov.com.
- When I log into Sitecore, I am taken to the Connecticut's Official State Website
 (https://authoring.ct.gov/). How do I get to my Agency website to edit?
 Please be sure to use the following URL when attempting to log into Sitecore:
 https://authoring.ct.gov/sitecore/login This should redirect you to your Agency website homepage or the Sitecore Experience Platform upon log in.
- 3. How do I unlock a page locked by another person to make edits?

 Agency System Administrators can override any locked pages/items through the following instructions: https://portal.ct.gov/Training/Content-Author/Lock-and-Unlock-a-Page#unlock
- 4. I deleted a page, but it is still showing in the navigation menu on the website and the url still works. For System Admins to remove a page from their website, the folder that contained the deleted page must be published to capture the action of deleting the page. Doing this ensures any deleted pages within that folder will be deleted from the live website as well. To learn more about deleting items, visit Deleting a Page or Content Folder.
