ORDER

The September 6, 2016 decision of the Supreme Court, <u>Estate of Rock v.</u>

<u>University of Connecticut</u>, 323 Conn. 26 (2016), reversed in part the board's October 16, 2014 Opinion holding "an estate is not a legal entity capable of advancing a claim for any form of workers' compensation benefits," Id., 28. In light of the Supreme Court's decision, the board's conclusion that an estate can act as a "legal representative" of the deceased employee is vacated. In all other respects our opinion stands.
