REMAND ORDER

On December 14, 2020, claimant filed a Petition for Review from the trial commissioner's December 1, 2020 ruling granting respondent's Form 36. The ruling was the result of an informal hearing. No transcripts or exhibits exist; therefore, it appears no record was created upon which the board can reach a determination on the issues presented in this appeal. Due process requires an evidentiary hearing at which a record can be created. The Compensation Review Board cannot review or consider this appeal under General Statutes Section 31-301 (a) in the absence of an evidentiary record.

The matter is therefore remanded to the trial commissioner acting for the Eighth District for a formal hearing or other appropriate action. See <u>Coccagna v. Henderson</u> <u>Global Investors, Inc.</u>, 5653 CRB-1-11-5 (May 25, 2011).
