## **REMAND ORDER**

The Respondents filed an appeal on November 18, 2021 from the November 10, 2021 Order by the Administrative Law Judge acting for the Sixth District, ordering the “[e]mployer to submit wage information to insurance company and employee by 11/15/2021, failure to comply will result in a fine of \$100.00 per day.” The ruling was the result of an informal hearing. It appears that no record was created upon which the Board can reach a determination on the issues presented in this appeal. Due process requires an evidentiary hearing where a record can be created. The Compensation Review Board cannot properly review or consider this appeal under General Statutes Section 31-301 (a).

This matter is therefore remanded to the Administrative Law Judge acting for the Sixth District for a Formal hearing or other appropriate action. See Young v. North American Family Institute, 6350 CRB-5-19-10 (October 8, 2019).
