Nokes, Angel Bruno, Brooke Foley, Kyle Zimmer, and Robert Ziobrowski.

Present from the public were Attorney Kenneth Katz and Justin Moulton.

Ross Hollander was excused while doing business out-of-state.

#### 1. Opening Remarks

Chairman Riley welcomed everyone present. He welcomed the new members and provided an overview of the duties of the Advisory Board. Everyone present introduced themselves.
