Memorandum of Findings and Determination

On October 6, 2020 the Connecticut Department of Transportation (CTDOT) published a Notice of Scoping in the *Environmental Monitor* to solicit comments for the subject project. A virtual public scoping meeting was held on October 27, 2020; and the scoping period concluded on November 10, 2020. During the scoping period, CTDOT received various comments from the public as well as from the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection.

Based on the comments received, and the analysis documented in the attached Environmental Review Checklist, CTDOT does not recommend the preparation of an Environmental Impact Evaluation under the Connecticut Environmental Policy Act. Comments and recommendations received were reviewed in conjunction with the preparation of the Environmental Review Checklist and addressed within the checklist, as appropriate.
