The Department of Public Health (DPH) received comments from the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) on June 21, 2019, the DEEP Natural Diversity Data Base on June 28, 2019 and a response from Groton Utilities on September 24, 2020. The DPH will coordinate with Groton Utilities, Norwich Public Utilities, Ledyard WPCA and the Town of Preston to ensure that the recommendations are implemented.
