On June 8, 2021 the Connecticut Department of Transportation (CTDOT) published a Notice of Scoping in the *Environmental Monitor* to solicit comments for the subject project, and the scoping period concluded on July 9, 2021. During the scoping period, CTDOT only received comments from the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (CTDEEP).

Based on the comments received, and the analysis documented in the attached Environmental Review Checklist, CTDOT does not recommend the preparation of an Environmental Impact Evaluation under the Connecticut Environmental Policy Act. Comments and recommendations received were reviewed in conjunction with the preparation of the Environmental Review Checklist and addressed within the checklist, as appropriate. CTDOT will continue to coordinate with CTDEEP as the project progresses.
