## LON Crosswalk W/CCH Rate Checklist

- $\circ$  What is level (# hrs. to be left alone)-to determine > 24 hours
- Have to give parameters
- Never been defined
- Physical Self Maintenance Scale
  - Used to get better picture of physical needs
  - Score Domains A F (A=toileting, B=feeding, C=dressing, D=grooming, E=physical ambulation, F=bathing)
- Review of LON
  - Took a sample of 12 people with LON 1 & 2
  - $\circ$   $\;$  Look at common indicators
  - Not create new tool, but a subset of questions that result in a CCH score
  - Identify elements that would indicate the need for a higher level of supervision
  - Total raw score then determine break-off for the different rates
  - $\circ$  Should LON 1 2 be limited to Rate 1
  - $\circ~$  Much discussion on amounts attached to rates  $\sim$  do they need to be adjusted at the various LON levels if so, what would funding impact be
  - $\circ~$  If we go with LON levels to determine rates URR would be for exceptions to move to a higher rate
  - LON should work for majority ~ URR should be very few

- Recommend following:
  - LON scores to readjust to Rate 1, 2, & 3 the cost. Tim O'Brien analyzed current data (handout)
  - Changing contract language
  - South Region \* Determine how many need to go to URR
  - RN language for CTV Contract
