ENGINEERING & CONSTRUCTION DIRECTIVE

Bureau Chief/Chief Engineer

Highway Boundary Markers

This directive establishes a standard of practice for the installation of CT state highway boundary (Right-of-Way) markers.

All future construction projects which establish new highway Right-of-Way lines or affect existing Right-of-Way monumentation as indicated in a milestone review by Central Surveys, shall add permanent monumentation as an item of construction to be provided by the contractor. Central Surveys shall be included in all milestone reviews (30%, 60%, 90%) for projects which may impact highway Right-of-Way.

Markers to be set shall be indicated during milestone reviews and called out on property acquisition maps prepared during the project ROW phase.

When Central Surveys determines new monumentation is required they shall provide the appropriate lead designer with the following:

- CAD file containing said monumentation and pertinent callouts for reference with designer's subset
- Highway Boundary marker installation methods and procedures
- Estimate for proposed monumentation to be performed by contractor
