Calculations for Incidental Costs Associated with Municipal Systems Projects (MSAT)

Below is a proposed change to the calculations for Incidental Costs associated with Municipal Systems Projects (MSAT). This Directive supersedes a memorandum from August 2009.

All projects advertised after March 1, 2023, will be following these revised incidental costs.

After considerable review of historical data and in discussions with Office of Engineering staff and District Municipal Teams, it was determined to revisit the method of calculation for the initial Incidental Costs establishment.

Project Type	Total Incidentals	Contingency
Less than \$1 Million	20%	10%
\$1 Million to \$5 Million	20%	10%
\$5 Million to \$10 Million	10%	10%
\$10 Million to \$20 Million	10%	7%
