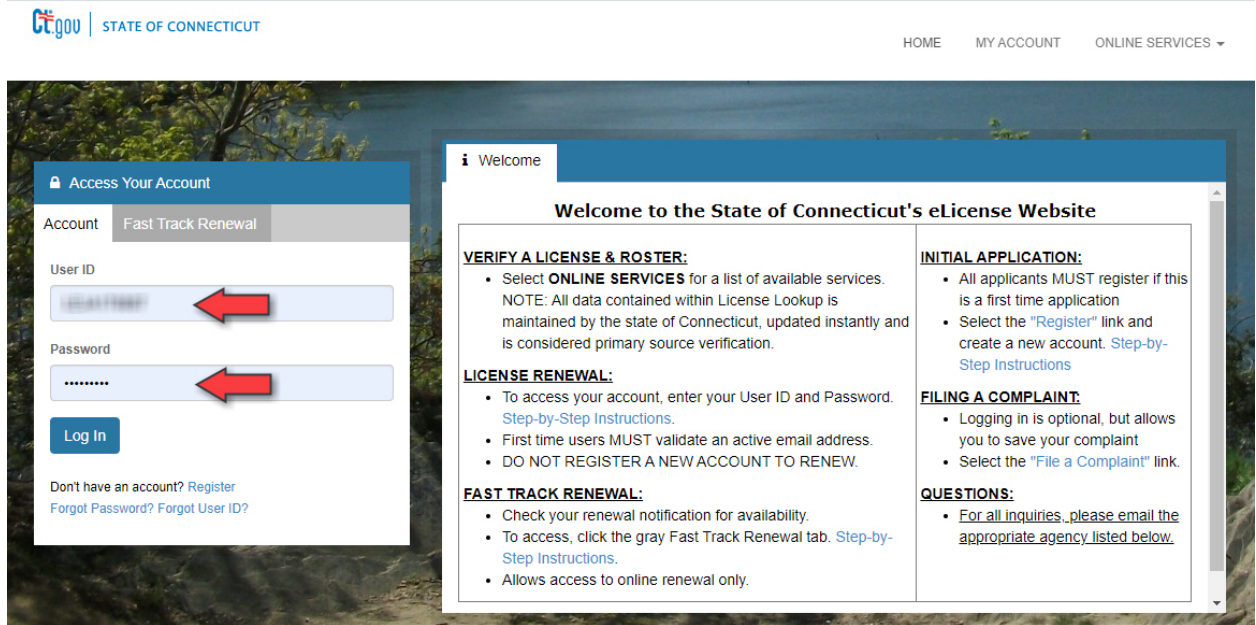
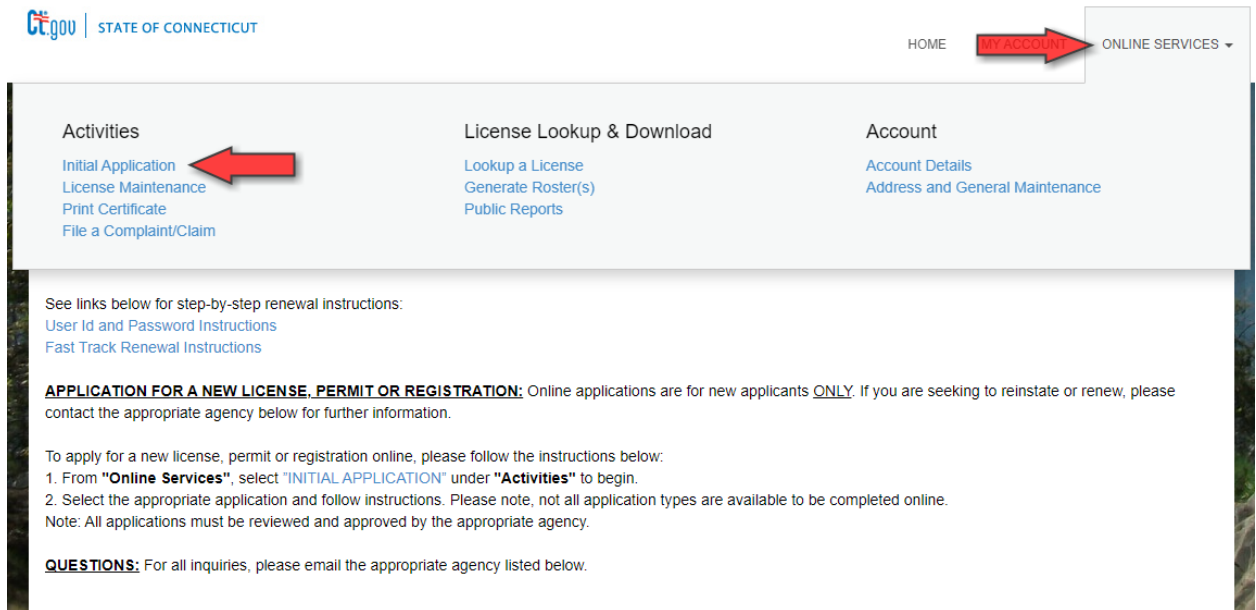


Instructions on How to Submit Report for May 14, 2024 THC-Infused Beverage Inventory

1. Go to <https://www.elicense.ct.gov/>. Create an account or log into your existing account.



2. Under "Online Services" select "Initial Application".



3. Under “Adult-Use Cannabis” click on “Start” next to “THC Infused Beverage Report (THCR).”

THC Infused Beverage Instructions

Welcome to the Department of Consumer Protection online application system.

Any business that offers THC infused beverages for retail sale must do a count of THC infused beverages by May 14, 2024.

THC infused beverages are non-alcoholic drinks with hemp or cannabis included. This may be displayed as Delta-8, Delta-9, THCA, HHC or similar. If you are unsure whether you have a THC infused beverage, contact your supplier.

IF YOU HAVE BEVERAGES CONTAINING THC FOR RETAIL SALE, YOU MUST DO THE FOLLOWING:

- On May 14, 2024: Count the number of containers you have of THC infused beverages; and,
- No later than June 15, 2024:
 - Report the number of containers of THC infused beverages from your May 14, 2024 count; and,
 - Pay a \$1 fee for each container reported in your count.

If you have multiple locations, you must conduct and report a separate count for each location. If you have more than one license for a location (for example, you hold an ENDS Dealer License, Gasoline, and Non-Legend Drug Permit at one location), you only need to report your count and pay the container fee once for that location.

IMPORTANT: Effective July 1, 2024, only cannabis retail establishments and package stores are allowed to sell beverages containing THC.

To report your inventory and pay the container fee, please click next to proceed with application.

THC Infused Beverage Definitions

Please review the following definitions before going forward:

- **Infused Beverage** means a beverage that:
 1. is not an alcoholic beverage, as defined in section 30-1 of the general statutes,
 2. is intended for human consumption, and
 3. contains, or is advertised, labeled or offered for sale as containing, total THC that is not greater than three milligrams per container
- **Legacy Infused Beverage** means a beverage that:
 1. is not an alcoholic beverage, as defined in section 30-1 of the general statutes,
 2. is intended for human consumption, and
 3. contains, or is advertised, labeled or offered for sale as containing, THC, as defined in section 21a-240 of the general statutes, as amended by this act, and
 4. as of June 30, 2024, is in compliance with:
 1. the provisions of RERACA, as defined in section 21a-420 of the general statutes, as amended by this act, and
 2. the policies and procedures issued by the Commissioner of Consumer Protection to implement, and any regulations adopted pursuant to, RERACA, as defined in section 21a-420 of the general statutes, as amended by this act
