# FUNDAMENTALS OF SUCCESSFUL REFORM

- **Invest in Collaboration**
  - Convene the Stakeholders
  - Recognize and Invest in Current Initiatives
  - Recognize there is “No Silver Bullet”
  
- **Embrace a Shared Mission**
  - Value over Volume/Quality over Quantity
  - Right Care, Right Time, Right Place
  - Access/Quality/Affordability
  - Measure Success



## FUNDAMENTALS OF SUCCESSFUL REFORM (cont.)

- **Educate and Engage Consumers & Employers**
  - Quality
  - Transparency
  - Wellness
  - Digital Tools
  - Telehealth
  
- **Address the Major Cost Drivers**
  - Unit Cost and Utilization
  - Hospitals
  - Pharmaceuticals
  - Public Payer Cost-Shift
  - Mandates/Fees/Assessments



## CORE COMPONENTS OF SUCCESSFUL RESOLUTION

- **First “Do No Harm.”**
  - Understand the Population Impacted (Less than 14% of CT’s total population subject to state regulation)
  - Conduct Cost/Benefit Analyses of Proposed Policy Changes
  - Support Evidence Based Practice, Safety, and Affordability Applications
  - Foster Innovation



## CORE COMPONENTS OF A SUCCESSFUL RESOLUTION (cont.)

- **Target the Major Cost Drivers**
  - Support and Invest in Value Based Purchasing
  - Benefit Designs that Foster High Quality Lower Cost Treatment
  - Hold Stakeholders Accountable



## Hold Stakeholders Accountable

- **Payers**

- Rate Review and Approval (current law)
- Medical Loss Ratio Standards/Premium Rebates (current law)
- Benchmark Reporting (current law)
- CID Report Card Standards (current law)
- All Payer Claims Database Reporting (current law)

- **Hospitals**

- Establish Benchmark Accountability and Answerability
- Acknowledge Role of Contract Negotiations in Cost Mitigation
- Assure Reimbursements Reflect the Actual Site of Care
- Adopt NASHP Models regarding Anti-Tiering and Anti-Steering
- Modernize Certificate of Need Policy



## Hold Stakeholders Accountable (cont.)

- **Pharmaceuticals**
  - Identify areas of State Authority over Pharmaceutical Pricing
  - Establish Benchmark Accountability and Answerability
  - Preserve Tools that: 1) Foster use of Clinically Appropriate Lower Cost Alternatives; and, 2) Drive Competition in the Market thereby Lowering Costs
- **Public Programs**
  - Assess and Address the Cost-Shift



## CORE COMPONENTS OF A SUCCESSFUL RESOLUTION (cont.)

- **Strengthen the Exchange – Access Health CT**
  - Establish Goals and Measure Performance
  - Explore Redetermination Auto-Enrollment
  - Allow Exchange Carriers to Directly Market and Assist with Enrollment
- **Address the Workforce Shortage**
  - Foster the Provider Workforce Pipeline
  - Expand Scope of Practice Laws for Mid-Level Practitioners
  - Allow Providers to Practice at Maximum of License
- **Embrace Technology**
  - Recognize and Foster Technology as a Means of Increasing Quality and Efficiency in Health Care
