RE: MVPD Appraiser and Casualty Adjusters Expiration Date Changes

<u>Public Act No. 24-138: An Act Concerning Insurance Market Conduct and Insurance Licensing, the Insurance Department's Technical Corrections and Other Revisions to the Insurance Statutes and Captive Insurance</u>

Sec. 4. Subsection (a) of section 38a-790 (MVPD Appraiser)

Sec. 5. Subsection (a) of section 38a-792 (Casualty Adjuster)

### Effective October 1, 2024:

Individual MVPD Appraiser and Casualty Adjuster licenses that are issued on or after October 1, 2024 will receive a new expiration date of two years after the licensee's last day of the birth month that preceded the date the license was issued.

Existing licensees will continue with the June 30, 2025 expiration date. After the license renewal has been issued, the expiration date will automatically convert to the licensee's last day of the birth month.

Business Entity license expiration dates will not be affected by this change. The license expiration date will remain June 30<sup>th</sup> of each odd-numbered year.
