### Notice to Health Insurance Issuers of Individual and Group Plans

The Connecticut Insurance Department (CID), at the request of The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS), is providing this Notice as guidance to confirm that all Health Insurance Issuers are in compliance with direct enforcement by CMS.

CMS is responsible for enforcing provisions of title XXVII of the Public Health Service Act (PHS Act), as amended or extended by the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ACA) and the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021 (CAA), among other laws, with respect to health insurance issuers in the individual and group markets when a state, such as Connecticut, does not have authority to enforce one or more of the applicable provisions of that title, or when CMS determines that a state or territory is not substantially enforcing one or more of the applicable provisions of that title.
