TO: RISK RETENTION GROUPS DOING BUSINESS IN THE STATE OF CONNECTICUT

SUBJECT: 2010 and 2011 FINANCIAL FILING REQUIREMENTS

Section 38a-253 of the Connecticut General Statutes requires that each risk retention group doing business in this state shall on or before March 1, 2011, submit to the commissioner, by electronically filing with the National Association of Insurance Commissioners, a true and complete report, signed and sworn to by its president or a vice-president, and secretary or an assistant secretary, of its financial condition as of December 31, 2010, prepared as submitted to its state of domicile, which shall be certified by an independent public accountant. In addition to this report a statement of opinion on loss and loss adjustment expense reserves and the Exhibit of Premiums and Losses (page 19) for the State of Connecticut is required to be filed by March 1, 2011.

Each risk retention group is required to submit quarterly statements, as provided to its domiciliary state, by electronically filing with the National Association of Insurance Commissioners. An Exhibit of Premiums and Losses (page 19) for the State of Connecticut will be required to be submitted on a quarterly basis in paper copy. Quarterly filings are to be made as follows:

March 31, 2011	May 15, 2011
June 30, 2011	August 15, 2011
September 30, 2011	November 15, 2011
