A **Letter of Clearance** is issued for a Connecticut resident agent who is or has moved to another state and is applying for a resident license in their new home state.

*Note: Requesting a Letter of Clearance will cancel your Connecticut license and all company appointments will be canceled. The licensee is the only party authorized to request cancellation of his/her license.
