New Cloud Software Products and Services Contract

DAS Procurement has posted a PARTIAL AWARD for cloud software products and services. DAS Procurement signed a Participating Addendum from a NASPO Value-point Contract led by the State of Utah. Negotiations with the most advantageous prospers continue so that a larger pool of resources will be available to our customers. This contract will provide the flexibility to allow Agencies to order IT Software as a Service (SaaS), Infrastructure as a Service (IaaS), and Platform as a Service (PaaS) solutions.

2019 Matchmaker Event


