➤ CEN Outreach Events

➤ CEN Staffing

- CEN currently has 9 full time staff members, 4 part time student workers.
- Director position closed on 11.28 and interview process is ongoing.
- Lead Technical Engineer position to be posted shortly.

➤ Network Traffic and DDOS

- For Nov-Dec, we saw a high of ~65GBPS across all external peering and caching with the maximum recorded sustained bandwidth on Thursday, November 17th, between 11:30-13:30, at 120GBPS.
- CEN has completed upgrades in West Haven for a 100G capable Juniper router, and is in discussions with CenturyLink on pricing/availability, and lead times for a 100G connection.
- Since September 1st, CEN has detected and mitigated 167 volumetric DDoS attacks.
- CEN is looking to automate notification of mitigated attacks to provide our members awareness that CEN took action against an attack on their behalf. We are getting close to a solution.

➤ NYC Buildout and Peering progress

- CEN continues to work with our partners through NEREN to build out to NYC. NEREN has submitted a letter of intent to the vendor, GDT, for purchase of optical equipment for the build. A formal purchase order from NEREN has not yet been issued; however, NEREN is still optimistic of the target completion date of March 2017.
- First member connections to Amazon AWS Direct Connect service through our MASS-IX connectivity have been established.
