Re: Section 1101.1

I support the use of Chapter 11 of the CFSC Part III and the elimination of CFSC Part IV for existing buildings, however I offer an exception that permits the continued use of an existing building that is compliant with the prior edition of CFSC Part IV in lieu of applying CFSC Part III Chapter 11.

This is consistent with the permissions in Section 804.2 of the IEBC and Section 1.3.6 of the of the CSFPC.

1101.1 Scope. The provisions of this chapter shall apply to existing buildings constructed prior to the adoption of this code.

EXCEPTION. BUILDINGS IN EXISTENCE OR PERMITTED FOR CONSTRUCTION PRIOR TO JANUARY 1, 2006 THAT ARE COMPLIANT WITH PART IV OF THE CFSC MAY BE CONTINUED IN USE.
