- b) **A-23-18** Request for Appeal received from Attorney Majorie Shansky 11/14/23 RE: [198 Commerce Street, East Haven, CT] of East Haven Fire Marshal, C.G.S. Section 29-309. Abatement Order of Fire/Life Safety Hazards – change of use. Refer to OSFM. Onsite inspection to be scheduled once Appellant receives report from hired code consultant. **As of 5/8/24, OSFM received no response from Appellant. Hold on agenda until next meeting.**
