Do edge metal profile system that are required by Section 1504.5 of the 2012 International Building Code portion of the 2016 State Building and are found in National Roofing Contractors Association (NRCA) roofing manual approved by Underwriters Laboratories (UL) and Intertek Testing Services (ITS) certifying compliance with ANSI/SPRI ES and are constructed by a NRCA Authorized Fabricator required to be tested for each individual project in which they are used?
