MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETINGS

The Board voted unanimously to approve minutes of the June 14, 2012 & July 12, 2012 Heating, Piping, Cooling and Sheet Metal Work Examining Board meetings.

APPLICATIONS

Horace H. Dixon, Hamden, CT – (S-2) Unlimited Journeyperson – Denied

The Board voted unanimously to deny Mr. Dixon's application due to lack of an apprenticeship completion from New York or registration in Connecticut and proof of related instruction.

Kevin D. Beckwith, Niantic, CT – (S-2) Unlimited Journeyperson – Approved for (S-10) Mr. Beckwith, after discussion with the Board, chose to amend the category of license sought on his application from (S-2) to (S-10). The Board voted unanimously to approve Mr. Beckwith's application based on equivalent experience and training, subject to its submission of his application in a manner acceptable to the Department's standards.

Frederick E. Smith, Ansonia, CT – (D-2) Limited Journeyperson – Denied The Board voted to deny Mr. Smith's application due to lack of an apprenticeship completion certificate.

Craig J. Kurker, Meriden, CT – (S-10) Limited Journeyperson – Approved for (D-2)

Mr. Kurker, after discussion with the Board, chose to amend the category of license sought on his application from (S-10) to (D-2). The Board voted unanimously to approve Mr. Kurker's application based on equivalent experience and training, upon his submission of his application in a manner acceptable to the Department's standards.. The Board suggested that Mr. Kurker should have his father, an (S-1), register him as either an (S-2) or (S-10) apprentice, so that going forward he might receive favorable consideration for one of those license types should a hardship later develop in the family run business.

The Board voted unanimously to approve Mr. Daros's application based on equivalent experience and training.

Brandon C. Drake, Goshen, CT – (S-9) Limited Contractor – Denied

The Board voted unanimously to deny Mr. Drake's application due to lack of an (S-10) journeyperson license or occupational related experience and training documentation. The Board requests that Mr. Drake appear in person at their next meeting.

Hussein M. Alyelsherif, Niantic, CT – (S-2) Unlimited Journeyperson – Denied

The Board voted unanimously to deny Mr. Alyelsherif's application based on lack of knowledge as to whether or not Mr. Alyelsherif's sufficiently documents equivalent experience and training. The Board requests that Mr. Alyelsherif appear in person at their next meeting.
