- 1. Call to Order by Greg McMahon. Public Meeting Requirements were reviewed.

- 4. McDowell Update
  - A flyer will be released in the last week of April announcing May STEP forums. It will first be released DDS staff, ARPA committees, providers, individuals & families, and other stakeholders. It will be sent via snail mail to individuals and legal representatives.

- 5. Service Description Review the committee was asked for feedback on making descriptions understandable, clear, broad, and general. These will be part of a package that includes videos. The goal is to have these done by the forums. The following service descriptions were reviewed: Supportive Housing, Remote Supports, Self-Direction, and Community Companion Homes.
  - Questions & feedback
    - Adding too many terms may make things confusing.
    - "Easy access to transportation" was clarified to "public transportation"
    - ? about adding nursing to Supported Housing under challenges. Not necessary. Nursing would be offered by a nursing agency, based on individual need.
    - Important to review all descriptions to be sure to use consistent, standard terminology on each on.

- For Remote Supports, use same sentence that was used in Individualized Support description to highlight Remote Supports can be combined with Assistive Technology and Individualized Home Supports.
- ➤ Remote Supports Challenges Suggestions: "learning how to use equipment" "language capacity of technology
