<u>South Central</u>: Tesha is working with CPAC on Focused Monitoring School districts. She has done tow rotations of FM. Districts are still using "time out rooms', which they are not supposed to do. If there is a window and not lock on the door then it is legal. Tesha will hold the focus group and forum for the Medical Home. Tesha also is reviewing grant proposals for the B-3 folks.
