- **Citizen Comment** Ms. Lewis commented on the legislative advocacy activities of CT DDS Families First, which is comprised of DDS families advocating for ID in Connecticut.

Ms. Bridges-Parent commented on her concern for the safety of individuals residing in ICFs and CLAs during transport and the need for stronger staff training in this area.

- **Field Activity Report** FY20-21 budget passed.

Regional Director's Updates: Regional Director Dailey shared the following updates:

- FY20-21 budget finalized → favorable to DDS for the most part
- LON and guardian stipend billed died in committee
- Supported decision making bill died in committee, but will be revisited
- Repeal of CCH room and board language passed → it's a good thing for DDS
- HB7424 passed Allows providers subject to cost settlement the ability to retain 20% of their savings
- SB945 passed Allows OPM to pilot incentive program that selects eight non-profit providers to retain a portion of their savings. Providers must serve people with ID, physical/mental disabilities, or ASD
- HB1093 passed- Creates taskforce to study employment opportunities for persons with ID
- Waitlist Initiatives → CCH, elderly caregiver
- \$5.6M Emergency Initiative Update → activities designed to avert emergencies and hospital admissions:
 - DDS Step-Down Unit is operational
 - o Enhanced IFS Teams are on board statewide
 - o DCF/DDS Collaboration for Emergency Mobile Psychiatric Service
 - o Clifford Beers/DDS Collaboration for Intensive Care Management

- RFP for three emergency transitional housing sites issued (Meriden, Norwich, and Wilton)
- o Enhanced Family Support Services Brochure → aligned with 211
- o Interagency outreach and education → Understanding DDS Presentation
- Hardship funding and rate increase for DDS Providers
- DDS policy and procedures related to the provider discharge process on
- Management of DDS' respite centers to shift from the Division of Public Services to the IFS Division effective June 21, 2019
- IP Repository
- IEP Direct
- Staffing

New Business: Council members agreed to ramp up member recruitment efforts.

Council Open Discussion: Discussion ensued on the DDS census and STS.
