# How is CE Different from Other Services?



#### **CERTIFIED STAFF**

Only staff with active CE Certifications can provide this

service. CE is designed to ensure that YOU are the person leading the way! The service requires greater participation of family, personal networks, and extended supports. CE uses a service team approach.

#### **GOALS**

In most cases, positions gained through CE did not exist beforehand. You and your CE staff member work with employers to create a customized position that fits the unmet needs of the employer and your likes, skills, interests, and abilities. The CE certified staff member will work with you, your employer, and your natural supports (those around who support you like a coworker or neighbor) to identify and put in place potential adjustments or accommodations (timers, task lists, etc.) necessary to assist you in your new job.

# CUSTOMIZED EMPLOYMENT (CE) SERVICES

Do you want to work but are struggling to find a job? Customized Employment (CE) is a newer service for job seekers who have not been able to get a competitive job through other employment services. CE focuses on your strengths, skills and abilities and the unmet needs of employers. This approach takes time, and you are the one leading the way. It is very structured and follows a specific process that is organized in three separate phases:



- JOB NEGOTIATION, DEVELOPMENT, AND PLACEMENT
- POST-EMPLOYMENT SUPPORTS





# **JOB DISCOVERY**

# **Getting to know you**

The focus of Job Discovery is not to find a job, but to meet with you and identify up to 3 employment areas of interests.

# Team approach



Discovery is time spent between you, your family, and a CE Certified Staff Member to gain a deeper understanding of your interests, likes, dislikes, knowledge, strengths, skills, and abilities.

#### Carried out over time

The average timeframe for Discovery is



between 5-7 weeks. This is different for everyone; the approach is individualized.

# Discovery activities may include:

- Observation of you at home
- Meetings with you in community based or family activities.
- Interviewing your circle:
  - Family members
  - o Friends
  - Support team
  - Other; neighbors, community members, etc.

Information learned is used to create a Visual Resume (or portfolio or traditional resume, whatever works best!), a Discovery Report and Customized Employment Plan that will lead the remainder of the service. You will review the plan with your team.

You have the final say.

# JOB NEGOTIATION, DEVELOPMENT, AND PLACEMENT NEGOTIATION


### **Negotiation**

CE Certified Staff member and you will approach employers and businesses together.

A list of job tasks that fit you has been created to offer potential employers when the unmet needs of a business identified in job development match your strengths and interests.

# POST-EMPLOYMENT SUPPORTS

# **On-the-Job**

Post-Employment Supports refer to any "onthe-job" support services that may be necessary to guide you as you learn your job and meet your employer's needs. You will have access to continued supports such as job coaching to maintain your skills and keep your job.

#### **Transition**

Once you are employed, you will transition to natural supports or an Individual Supported Employment (ISE) placement. This will allow you to access supports and services from an employment specialist who can provide training and assistance as needed.
