DDS Legislative Update – March 30, 2012

Appropriations Committee's Mid-Term Budget, Deaf Child Bill of Rights included in Special Education Bill and DDS Bill Tracking

Appropriations Committee Votes on its Mid-Term Budget Adjustments.

On Thursday, March 29, 2012, the Appropriations Committee voted on H.B. No. 5014 - An Act Making Adjustments to State Expenditures and Revenues for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2013. This bill's Joint Favorable Substitute (JFS) language makes changes to the Governor's proposed Mid-Term Budget Adjustments. Now that the bill has been voted out of the Committee, there will be negotiations between the Governor's office and the House and Senate leadership to reconcile the two versions of the Mid-Term Budget Adjustments. The final version of the bill must be passed by a majority in both the House and the Senate and then be signed by the Governor. Below are links to the Appropriations Committee's Mid-Term Budget Adjustments for the Department of Developmental Services (DDS) included in H.B. No. 5014 and the Appropriations Committee's Mid-Term Budget Adjustments for All State Agencies. This document shows (1) what the Governor has proposed for the Mid-Term Budget Adjustments; (2) what the Appropriations Committee recommends; and (3) the difference between the two versions of the Mid-Term Budget Adjustments. The main differences include a reduction to the personal services and other expenses accounts. Additionally, funding for the private provider COLA has been included in the DDS budget instead of the Office of Policy and Management's. DDS staff are in the process of evaluating the impact of the Appropriations Committee's version of the mid-term budget adjustments.
