Program Review and Investigations

March 16th was the Joint Favorable (JF) deadline for the **Legislative Program Review and Investigations Committee (LPRIC)** by which date the Committee had to vote to pass their bills onto, either the Senate or the House or to other legislative committees. The Committee decided NOT to vote out **H.B. No. 5036** - **An Act Implementing the Recommendations of the Legislative Program Review and Investigations Committee Concerning the Provision of Selected Services for Persons with Intellectual Disability.** This bill's provisions were based on certain recommendations from the LPRIC study: Provision of Selected Services for Clients with Intellectual Disability. The Legislative Program Review and Investigations Committee will instead be tracking the department's progress on the Five Year Plan.
