The Committee requests that testimony be limited to matters related to the items on the Agenda. The first hour of the hearing is reserved for State Agency Heads. The time period from 3:00 P.M. until 4:00 P.M. is reserved for an invited panel of chief elected municipal officials. Speakers will be limited to three minutes of testimony. The Committee encourages witnesses to submit a written statement and to condense oral testimony to a summary of that statement. Unofficial sign-up sheets have no standing with the Committee. All public hearing testimony, written and spoken, is public information. As such, it will be made available on the CGA website and indexed by internet search engines.
