DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENTAL SERVICES TESTIMONY BEFORE THE COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC HEALTH

March 13, 2019

Senators Abrams and Somers, Representatives Steinberg and Petit and members of the Public Health Committee. I am Jordan Scheff, Commissioner of the Department of Developmental Services (DDS). Thank you for the opportunity to testify in support of <u>S.B. No. 920</u> AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH'S RECOMMENDATIONS FOR VARIOUS REVISIONS TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH STATUTES.

Specific to section 25 of the bill, DDS recently learned that the current language in section 17a-227a of the Connecticut General Statutes restricted the department's ability to provide a criminal history records check to <u>all</u> DDS employees that may have access to individuals with intellectual disability. As currently written, the statutory language only allows the department to submit a state and nation criminal history records check on applicants for employees may have access to individuals with intellectual disability." As all DDS employees may have access to individuals with intellectual disability, not just those who provide direct services, the department is proposing to expand the scope of the statute to require that each applicant who has been made an offer of conditional employment by the department, would be fingerprinted and submit to a state and national criminal history records check.

Requiring fingerprinting and background checks for all applicants for DDS employment was the original intent of the language that passed last session as part of section 52 of <u>Public Act No. 18-168</u>. Additional changes in section 25 are technical in nature and codify current practice.
