DDS Legislative Update – April 10, 2008

This legislative update is divided into three sections:

- Bills Proposed by DDS
- Senate Raised and Committee Bills Being Followed by DDS
- House Raised and Committee Bills Being Followed by DDS

Note: This update is not a comprehensive list of bills before the Connecticut General Assembly. DDS is tracking and assessing the bills listed below for their potential impact on DDS consumers, families and guardians, DDS employees and DDS providers.

Beginning with this legislative update, only bills that are still "alive" and can move forward are being tracked and listed in the update.

Once a committee's JF deadline has passed, a bill that has not been acted upon is considered "dead." A bill that has been referred to a committee by either the Senate or the House, generally, must be acted upon by the committee within three legislative session days or seven calendar days whichever deadline comes first. If it is not acted upon by the committee, the bill is "dead." Though a bill may have died, the concept or the language of the bill may resurface in the form of an amendment to another bill that is still "alive." An amendment must be pertinent or "germane" to the bill being amended.

Some bills in the Senate are placed on the "Foot of the Calendar", which means the bill needs further work or has a fiscal impact that needs to be addressed.

As the legislative session goes forward, bills will be referred from legislative committees to the House or Senate. The House or Senate then may refer the bills to other committees or chose to vote on them. In these updates, the last action taken on a bill will be in **bold**. For a bill to become a law, both the House and the Senate must vote favorably on it by May 7, 2008 at midnight and the Governor must sign the bill into law.

Key to Legislative Terminology:

JF means the committee reported the bill favorably to the House or Senate.

JF Change of Reference means the committee reported the bill favorably to another committee.

JFS means the committee reported the bill favorably to the House or Senate but with substitute language.

JFS Change of Reference means the committee reported the bill favorably to another committee but with substitute language.

A File Number (**File No.**) is a unique number given to a bill once it has reached the House or Senate Floor. A file copy of a bill with the file number has a plain-language description of what the bill's provisions do, written by the Office of Legislative Research

and a fiscal note that explains what a bill would cost or save to implement, written by the Office of Fiscal Analysis.

A House or Senate Calendar Number (**House or Senate Cal. No.**) is also a unique number that is given to a bill once it reaches the House or Senate Floor. This number is used to hold the bill's place on either the House or Senate Calendar. If the bill is a House bill (H.B. 5000 or higher) or a Senate bill (S.B.1 to 4999) it first gets a Calendar Number from the chamber the bill originated in. Once a House bill is passed in the House, it goes on to the Senate where it receives a Senate Calendar Number. Likewise once a Senate bill (with a Senate Calendar Number) passes the Senate, it goes to the House and receives a House Calendar Number.

No. 224, to make technical and other revisions to laws governing the Department of Children and Families regarding emergency placement of children, access to records, transfer of termination of parental right cases and the department's role and responsibility in Safe Havens cases.

definitions of sexual assault in the second degree and sexual assault in the fourth degree to include assaults committed on persons placed or treated under the direction of the Commissioner of Developmental Services.
