DDS Legislative Update - April 28, 2008

This legislative update is divided into three sections:

- Bills Proposed by DDS
- Senate Raised and Committee Bills Being Followed by DDS
- House Raised and Committee Bills Being Followed by DDS

Note: This update is not a comprehensive list of bills before the Connecticut General Assembly. DDS is tracking and assessing the bills listed below for their potential impact on DDS consumers, families and guardians, DDS employees and DDS providers.

This legislative update tracks Senate and House bills that are still "alive" and can move forward. If a bill has died since the previous update, it will be listed on this update and then removed on subsequent updates.

Once a committee's JF deadline has passed, a bill that has not been acted upon is considered "dead." A bill that has been referred to a committee by either the Senate or the House, generally, must be acted upon by the committee within three legislative session days or seven calendar days whichever deadline comes first. If it is not acted upon by the committee, the bill is "dead." Though a bill may have died, the concept or the language of the bill may resurface in the form of an amendment to another bill that is still "alive." An amendment must be pertinent or "germane" to the bill being amended. DDS tracks these amendments.

As the legislative session goes forward, bills will be referred from legislative committees to the House or Senate. The House or Senate then may refer the bills to other committees or chose to vote on them. In these updates, the last action taken on a bill will be in **bold**. For a bill to become a law, both the House and the Senate must vote favorably on it by May 7, 2008 at midnight and the Governor must sign the bill into law.

Key to Legislative Terminology:

JF means the committee reported the bill favorably to the House or Senate.

JF Change of Reference means the committee reported the bill favorably to another committee.

JFS means the committee reported the bill favorably to the House or Senate but with substitute language.

JFS Change of Reference means the committee reported the bill favorably to another committee but with substitute language.

A File Number (**File No.**) is a unique number given to a bill once it has reached the House or Senate Floor. A file copy of a bill with the file number has a plain-language description of what the bill's provisions do, written by the Office of Legislative Research and a fiscal note that explains what a bill would cost or save to implement, written by the Office of Fiscal Analysis.

A House or Senate Calendar Number (**House or Senate Cal. No.**) is also a unique number that is given to a bill once it reaches the House or Senate Floor. This number is used to hold the bill's place on either the House or Senate Calendar. If the bill is a House bill (H.B. 5000 or higher) or a Senate bill (S.B.1 to 4999) it first gets a Calendar Number from the chamber the bill originated in. Once a House bill is passed in the House, it goes on to the Senate where it receives a Senate Calendar Number. Likewise once a Senate bill (with a Senate Calendar Number) passes the Senate, it goes to the House and receives a House Calendar Number.

The "Foot of the Calendar" in the Senate means the bill needs further work or has a fiscal impact that needs to be addressed. Once a bill has been worked on, it can be **removed** from the Foot of the Calendar.

Public Act (PA) is a designation given to bills after they have passed both the State Senate and the State House of Representatives. The numbers listed after **Public Act (PA)** signify the year in which the bill was passed (08) plus a unique number denoting the order in which the bill became a Public Act. Public Acts must be signed by the Governor to become law.

S.B. No. 663 (RAISED) 'AN ACT PROVIDING STATE-FUNDED MEDICAL COVERAGE TO CHILDREN IN THE CARE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES AND THE DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENTAL SERVICES' File No. 604, Senate Cal. No. 400, to expand eligibility for state-funded medical assistance to include children under the care and supervision of the Department of Developmental Services who are ineligible for

Medicaid and to remove the institutional status of a child from being a factor in determining a child's eligibility for medical assistance.

H.B. No. 5131 (RAISED) 'AN ACT AMENDING THE STATUTES CONCERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES' File No. 393, House Cal.

No. 224, to make technical and other revisions to laws governing the Department of Children and Families regarding emergency placement of children, access to records, transfer of termination of parental right cases and the department's role and responsibility in Safe Havens cases.

Sec. 2(g)(17) (lines 429-431) allows DCF to disclose client records to the Department of Developmental Services for the purposes of eligibility and enrollment in the voluntary services program operated by DDS.

H.B. No. 5541 (RAISED) PUBLIC HEALTH. 'AN ACT CONCERNING SEXUAL ASSAULT OF PERSONS PLACED OR TREATED UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THE COMMISSIONER OF DEVELOPMENTAL SERVICES', to expand the definitions of sexual assault in the second degree and sexual assault in the fourth degree to include assaults committed on persons placed or treated under the direction of the Commissioner of Developmental Services.
