Vista Life Innovations (Vista) is a fully accredited, nationally recognized post-secondary program offering an array of services for adults with disabilities and their families from across the United States. Vista is accredited by the National Commission for the Accreditation of Special Education Services (www.NCASES.org). Located along the scenic south central shoreline of Connecticut, Vista has campuses in Westbrook, Madison and Guilford.

Vista offers services to individuals with Autism Spectrum Disorders, Traumatic Brain Injury, Learning Disabilities, Intellectual Disabilities, Seizure Disorders, ADHD and other neurological impairments. Vista provides a community based training program where individuals learn experientially. With practice in natural settings, Vista helps individuals learn the skills necessary to transition to adulthood and live successfully. A long term program with continued support is provided for individuals who wish to remain on the Connecticut shoreline and make it their home.

Vista offers a continuum of services and training for adults with disabilities aged 18 and above and their families. Skill areas addressed are employment, life skills, cognitive and social development, community involvement, transition services and the Connect program, which provides a structured experiential day program in a peer-based setting.

Vista also provides an extensive and diverse program of weekend activities, club offerings. The Connect through Art program offers a structured experiential arts-based day program in a peer-based setting. Students and members participating in this program have the opportunity to participate in a variety of projects in a range of mediums, including drawing, painting, sculpture, photography and more.

In addition Vista offers the following specialized services:

- Advocacy Services (life planning and advocacy)
- •Benefits Counseling (navigating adult entitlement programs for the disabled)
