# **Provider Description**

#### Information provided by the provider describing their agency:

Day Program: Osterer Center for Discovery is located at 94-96 South Turnpike Road in Wallingford, Connecticut. Our Day Program focuses on personal success, developing each individual's interests and emphasizing community inclusion. Our trained staff work with participants to choose and design goals to meet their specific individual needs and interests. Services and programs are provided on-site and in a variety of settings throughout the community. Our Day Program allows participants to spend their time engaging in enriching new experiences and in activities of interest to them. The Day Program operates year round from 8:00am - 5:00pm.

United Preschool Program: The United Preschool Center, located in White Plains, offers an integrated learning experience for children with and without disabiltiies. The Preschool provides special education and therapy for children with special needs ages 3 to 5. Program services operate weekdays between 8:30am to 2:30pm, with a 10 month session and six-week summer program. Approved by the New York State Department of Education the preschool provides a wide range of services including speech and language therapy, occupational and physical therapy, assistive techology, nursing, social work services, counseling, animal therapy and music therapy.

School Program: The CPW special education program is a New York State Department of Education approved school for children ages 5 to 21. The school program offers educational, therapeutic and medical services designed specifically for each child. All services offered are coordinated by an interdisciplinary team to meet the specific objectives of each student's individual educational program (IEP). The school operates a 10 month session with a six-week summer program.

High School Transition Services: Our program assists to maximize the potential and success of each student in their transition from school to an adult life. We work closely with School Districts, Committee on Special Education, the student and family to ensure a person centered plan is developed. These plans include the following services:

1. Discovery – observation, interview, career interest surveys, career exploration, situational assessments and work readiness.

2. Job Development / Work Experience – internship placement, job coachning and job shadowing.

3. Travel Training – transportation schedule planning, safety training in the community and supervised travel training to and from work sites.

#### Children's Recreational Services:

Play Therapy Program: The Kiyoko Brown Lekotek Program services children with disabilties and their families. For children with physical, cognitive, and sensory disabilties, Lekotek provides a way to learn and play by using specialized toys. Sessions are held to facilitate play in an environment that promotes interaction among family members. Sessions can take place at the Lokotek Center in Rye Brook or in your home.
