Bristol ARC is a private, non-profit, United Way organization which has provided services to men and women with intellectual and developmental disabilities for over sixty years.

Bristol ARC is committed to helping adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities achieve maximum independence by providing educational, vocational, residential, social and advocacy services that will support inclusion into the community.

Bristol ARC operates a restaurant, The Hidden Café and greenhouse, Jerome Gardens, that are open to the public year round. We also have a lawn maintenance service, a candy kitchen and an art program. In addition, we provide residential services, supported employment (individual and group), day support options, individualized day and recreation/respite programs.

Bristol ARC sponsors a self-advocacy group called "My Voice, My Choice." The group meets on the last Wednesday of every month except July and August. The organization is governed by a Board of Directors who meet every month or more frequently if needed.

Bristol ARC remains committed to its mission statement of "Advocating Personal Growth and Community Inclusion for All We Serve."
