The Institute first began operating in Connecticut in 1986 through its Division of Community and Residential Services that focused primarily on helping people leave large state-run institutions in Mansfield, Southbury and Waterford by creating residential alternatives that were integral parts of neighborhoods and communities. Since then the division has grown from five community residences to more than twenty, and consists of both Community Living Arrangements (CLAs) and Intermediate Care Facilities (ICF's). Our services have expanded beyond residential supports and now include:

- Community-based Employment and Vocational Programs
- Supported Living
- · Clinical and Program Consultation
- Training
- Autism Support and In-Home Family Supports

We believe that respect, compassion, and commitment are the essentials upon which services for individuals must be based.
