Information provided by the provider describing their agency:

At the Corner of Determination and Hope has one main site located in Plainfield, CT. Through individualized supported employment, group supported employment and transitional employment supports, individuals may choose to work at the restaurant, the retail shop or catering company, all located at the main site. For those who move on to employment with another employer, we also provide transitional support to ensure that their next position is also successful.

Group day services are also provided at the main site. The group day program provides education and training for basic activities of daily living, social communication training, social groups and recreational opportunities. The life skills programming is designed to build and foster increased independence for all individuals. We work with individuals to become as independent as possible in any living arrangement.

Additional support services are provided to individuals throughout our service area in their own homes. Through individualized day, personal support, IHS, companion support, respite and transportation we provide individuals with assistance with life skills, support to participate in community activities, respite services, individualized support within the home environment, and assistance to attend medical and dental appointments.
