A person centered and person directed approach is used to develop a unique support system for each person. Kinetic Potential provides a range of support services for both youth and adults to support people as they pursue and achieve their desired outcomes. Each person referred to Kinetic Potential will go through an individualized planning session that is centered on their personal needs, goals and expectations as established during their intake process or in the exploratory process that follows. Kinetic Potential will present to each client a plan that details a recommended set of supports based upon their criteria, budget considerations and a proposed timeline.
