Parents who are not identified as having any of the related diagnosis are provided supports in managing behavior as a part of the child's circle of support.

Dr. Phillips, CEO of Briason Associates, provide Clinical Behavior Supports throughout Connecticut to families registered for Connecticut Developmental Disabilities Services. Briason Associates provides parenting supports services to parents with cognitive impairments in Connecticut. Briason takes pride in assisting families to live more independent lives while supporting parents in daily engagement with their children. Briason also works closely with families to access community resources to support the needs of their family. Briason's trained professional staff conduct initial assessments to determine the specific needs of each family while establishing measurable goals that act as the prescription for service delivery. This includes training and oversight in all areas of family support. Staff provide on-sight care that includes community engagement and support in teaching parents how to navigate through life's daily occurrences. Briason has free online parent training courses every Monday 10-11:30am (English) and every Wednesday 10-11:30am (Spanish).
