Jewel Human Services, Inc. (JHS) is a nonprofit human services agency committed to empowering individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities to live meaningful, inclusive, and self-directed lives. JHS delivers person-centered supports designed to strengthen independence, community integration, and overall quality of life for individuals and families.

JHS provides a comprehensive continuum of OPWDD-aligned services in Brooklyn and Queens, New York, including Day Habilitation, Community Habilitation, In-Home Respite, Pre-Vocational Services, Supported Employment (SEMP), ACCES-VR vocational supports, Housing Subsidy/Independent Living supports, and Self-Direction services through Support Brokerage and Fiscal Intermediary (FI) programming. These programs are designed to meet individuals where they are—supporting daily living skills, social development, employment readiness, community participation, and long-term stability.

JHS emphasizes strong program oversight, compliance, and continuous quality improvement. The agency uses data-informed supervision practices, staff development, and cross-department collaboration to promote consistent service delivery and responsiveness to participant and family needs. JHS also prioritizes partnerships with community organizations, educational institutions, and workforce development resources to expand opportunities for individuals served.

As JHS prepares to expand services into Connecticut, the agency brings a proven model of culturally responsive, community-based support, grounded in dignity, respect, and individualized planning. JHS looks forward to building collaborative relationships with Connecticut stakeholders to enhance services for individuals with developmental disabilities and their families.
