SARAH Inc. is a private not-for-profit agency providing services and supports for children and adults of all ages and differing abilities throughout greater New Haven, across the Connecticut shoreline and in lower Middlesex County. SARAH Inc. is qualified by DDS to provide Employment Services, Enrichment (Day Supports) Services, Transitional Services, Individual and Family Supports, In-Home Supports and Medical/Clinical Coordination services.

In operation for over 60 years, SARAH Inc.'s mission is "To Enhance Skills and Enrich Lives of All Individuals with Differing Abilities." SARAH Inc. assists dozens of supported workers employed in retail, service and manufacturing jobs throughout our communities through our customized Employment Services. Workers can be independently employed with occasional supports or supervised and trained by a job coach. Trained Employment Specialists provide instruction in job seeking skills, developing work competencies, on the job skills training, destination/travel training, and ongoing supports and advocacy in communication with the supported worker, parents, care-providers and employers.

For those who are unable to work or choose not to work competitively our SARAH in Action Enrichment programs (Day support Options), based in our facilities in North Haven, Madison and Westbrook, offer day services tailored to meet an individual's needs and interests and enhance personal growth through cultural, educational and social activities. A typical day may involve learning computer skills, arts and crafts, and delivering Meals on Wheels and similar volunteer projects.

Transitional Services provide students, schools, families, as well as older adults, with the planning and supports to ensure that people with special needs and other differing abilities have a variety of work experiences to enhance their career development. Customized, individual plans focus on developing the skills needed to enter or reenter the workforce and to advance from group support work to better and more competitive jobs.

Individual and Family Supports are ideal for those who succeed with individual attention – whether to find a job, participate more fully in the life of their communities, or to offer respite and assistance in the home.

SARAH Inc.'s KIDSTEPS Children Services is a state approved, Birth to Three early intervention program for infants and children and their families.
