The agency operates a Recreation program funded through the town of Southington.

Other funding to support our programs such as our Respite Grant Program offered in the spring is received from the United Way of Southington, Southington Chamber of Commerce, Knights of Columbus, Southington Disabilities Commission, Calvanese Foundation, fundraising, memberships and private donations.
