24-hour Residential Services are offered at homes rented by residents and operated/supported by CVS staff Others receive residential supports in their own apartment or home residing more independently.

Day and Residential Services can range from community jobs, volunteerism, social, recreational connections and networking within the community. These supports can have a range of staff hours depending on each person's needs.
