
Who did we talk to...



In a 2017 survey of 368 people:

Community Inclusion

- Able to go out for errands in past month: 94%
- Able to go do things you like: 86%
- Able to go out for entertainment in past month: 82%
- Able to go to religious service or spiritual practice in past month: 36%

Relationships

- Has friends and can see them when you want to: 79%
- Often feels lonely: 10%
- Have someone to go to for help or if scared: 93%

Rights and Respect

- Has a key to the home: 45%
- Your name on lease: 10%
- Staff treated you with respect: 93%
