SERVICE DELIVERY

EMPLOYMENT ENRICHMENT SERVICE (EES)

Are you an employed individual who would like to continue skill building to maintain or expand employment? In EES, you can work on career upkeep and enhancement with the support of your peers. Examples of goals may include:

- pursue a certification
- improve soft skills
- achieve upward mobility
- identify additional career opportunities
- transition from sub-minimum wage to Competitive Integrated Employment (CIE)

EMPLOYMENT EXPLORATION OPTION (EEO)

Would you like to explore the possibility of work? In EEO, you will be introduced to employment and community inclusion with the support of your peers. EEO is a foundational inquiry into employment that can include:

- Discovery activities (tasks that involve an individual learning about themselves)
- Exploration activities (tasks that involve an individual learning about different careers)

EEO can be a steppingstone to pre-employment and employment services.

LIFE COURSE PLANNING

LifeCourse planning is built on the core belief that people and their families have the right to live, love, work, play, and pursue their life aspirations. In both EES and EEO, Charting the LifeCourse may be used to assist you in identifying employment goals and areas of interest.
